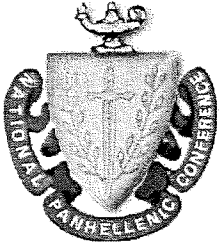

1. Collegiate Scholarships are awarded to Tulsa-area women attending a college, except TU, are members of a sorority and have completed 60 hours of college credit.
2. The University of Tulsa Scholarship is awarded to a TU student who also meets the same criteria.
3. Alumnae Scholarship is open to Tulsa-area women active in their local alumnae chapter, paid TAAP dues for two years and need assistance with higher education or work-related training.

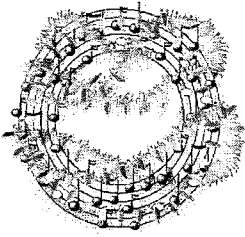

Sorority Recruitment Information Session

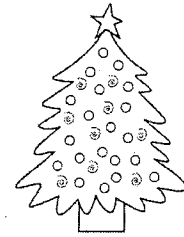

In other holiday news:

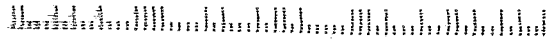
