Did you know that TAAP poinsettia sales benefit the Tulsa Public School Eyeglass Fund as well as awards to collegiate and alumnae students?

For the past several years, the TAAP Eyeglass Fund has provided financial assistance to children who are in need of an eye exam and/or corrective lenses and around \$10,000 in scholarships have been awarded annually. Last year we gave away \$8,000 in scholarships!

NPC FAST FACTS



Here are some published highlights from the Annual Survey of NPC Sororities (2020-2021 figures) across all 26 member organizations:

MEMBERSHIP |

- 5,588,276 women currently initiated into our organizations, a 2% increase from last year
- ♦ 367,647 total undergraduates reported, representing a 2% decrease from the last academic year; compared to 10 years prior, undergraduate membership remains high (2011-2012 overall undergraduate membership counted 302,792)
- ♦ 3,356 chartered and newly established collegiate chapters, a slight uptick from the previous year
- 3,430 active alumnae chapters

PHILANTHROPY |

- Collegiate and alumnae members together donated more than \$34 million for inter/national philanthropy activity (19 collegiate and 13 alumnae organization reported statistics)
- Nearly 930 thousand hours volunteered for philanthropy (based on 11 collegiate and 6 alumnae organizations reported statistics)

Due to the pandemic, not all new members were initiated in Spring 2020 and were deferred to Fall 2020. These deferred initiations are a factor in the increase in number of women initiated into NPC organizations in 2020-2021.
