- 5,772,678 women initiated into our organizations (26 member organizations reporting).
- 354,166 undergraduate members (26 member organizations reporting).
- 125,884 new members initiated (26 member organizations reporting).
- 3,309 chartered and newly established collegiate chapters.
- 3,453 active alumnae chapters, an increase of 23.

- Total dollars raised for all philanthropy organizations by alumnae and collegians: \$20,029,265. (17 member organizations reported statistics.)
- Total hours volunteered overall for philanthropy (partners and non-partners) by alumnae and collegians: 653,079. (8 member organizations reported statistics.)
